Essay Writing

Description: This course is projected to help students improve their skill in writing essays. The course encompasses concepts of essays as well as writing expository and argumentative essays. The course also equips students with skills in paraphrasing, summarizing, and referencing. Students are to complete various writing assignments and acquire the necessary skills for Thesis Writing and Proposal Seminar.
